This immersive land-and-sea adventure begins with a flight to Fairbanks and travels through Denali National Park, with stays at two wilderness lodges and scenic river and rail experiences. Then, board the *Crown Princess*® for a 7-day cruise through Alaska's iconic ports—Skagway, Juneau, and Ketchikan—plus breathtaking sights like Hubbard Glacier and Glacier Bay. The journey ends in vibrant Vancouver, blending natural wonders, rich history, and unforgettable wildlife encounters.

A deposit reserves your spot on the cruise. After the deposit due date, we may or may not be able to secure additional cabins. The deposit will be refundable until the final payment due date. Please make your deposit early to secure your cabin.

Day 1: Begin your journey with a motorcoach transfer to Atlanta for an overnight stay with a relaxing Kick Back reception.

Day 2: Transfer to the Atlanta airport for your flight to Fairbanks, Alaska—known as the “Golden Heart City.” Upon arrival, check into your hotel and take in the charm of this welcoming gateway to Alaska's interior.

Day 3: Start your day with a scenic cruise down the Chena River aboard an authentic Sternwheeler Riverboat, offering a glimpse into Alaska's frontier spirit. Then travel by motorcoach to Denali National Park and check into the Denali Princess Wilderness Lodge. Explore the lodge's river view deck, the festive Princess Village, and cozy spots like the Christmas cottage and sugar shack. Don't miss Fannie Q's Saloon, named after a legendary local homesteader.

Day 4: Enjoy a hearty buffet breakfast at Fannie Q's before heading out on a Natural History Tour of Denali National Park. Keep your eyes peeled for Denali's “Big Five”: bears, moose, caribou, wolves, and Dall sheep. Later, relax with a glass of wine on the deck overlooking the Nenana River or grab a bite at Grizzly Burger or Lynx Creek Pizza.

Day 5: Travel by motorcoach to McKinley State Park for a two-night stay at the Mt. McKinley Princess Wilderness Lodge. Take in sweeping views of the Alaska Range from the Great Room or the expansive deck. Hear tales of mountain climbers in the Hudson Theater or roast marshmallows at the fireside patio.

Day 6: Enjoy a full day at leisure. Visit the Tour Desk to book optional excursions, stroll the nature trails, or simply soak in the views of Denali—"The Great One"—from the lodge's custom-built treehouse, designed by Pete Nelson of *Treehouse Masters*.

Day 7: Journey by scenic domed train to Whittier, a small town nestled at the base of the Chugach Mountains. Originally built as a WWII port, Whittier is now a hub for fishing and tourism. Travel through the Anton Anderson Memorial Tunnel and arrive at the gateway to Prince William Sound, known for its tidewater glaciers and marine wildlife. Hop aboard the Crown Princess Cruise Ship where you'll discover a relaxing atmosphere filled with an array of world class entertainment and dining options that will greet you each day when you return from making fascinating discoveries ashore.

Day 8: Cruise past the mighty Hubbard Glacier, North America's largest tidewater glacier. Stretching 76 miles and plunging 1,200 feet into Disenchantment Bay, its vivid blue hues and towering ice face are mesmerizing. Watch for dramatic calving events and wildlife like whales, seals, otters, and seabirds.

Day 9: Sail through Glacier Bay, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and highlight of your cruise. Marvel at tidewater glaciers like Margerie Glacier and enjoy onboard presentations from Park Rangers, who also host a Junior Ranger program for kids. Keep an eye out for whales, eagles, and other wildlife as you glide through emerald waters.

Day 10: Step back in time in Skagway, once the bustling gateway to the Klondike gold fields. Explore its gold rush history, preserved buildings, and frontier charm. Though its population has dwindled since its heyday, the spirit of adventure still thrives here.

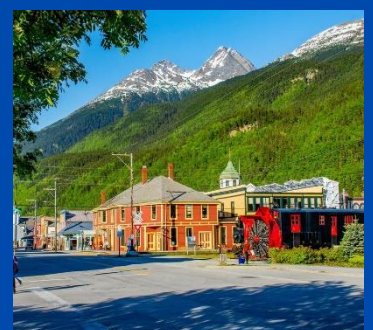
Day 11: Visit Juneau, Alaska's capital, founded after a major gold discovery in 1880. Once home to three of the world's largest gold mines, Juneau now blends government, history, and natural beauty. With stunning glaciers and mountain views, it's one of the largest cities by area in the world.

Day 12: Arrive in Ketchikan, Alaska's "First City." Rich in Native heritage and once a thriving fishing and timber town, Ketchikan offers the world's oldest collection of totem poles and access to the breathtaking Misty Fjords National Monument.

Day 13: Enjoy a relaxing day at sea aboard the Crown Princess®. Take in panoramic views from one of over 1,400 balconies, including the expansive Sky Suites. Savor Princess dining favorites and enjoy live entertainment and spectacular productions.

Day 14: Disembark in Vancouver, a stunning city nestled between mountains and sea. Explore historic Gastown, vibrant Chinatown, and scenic Stanley Park. Transfer to Seattle for your late night flight back to Atlanta.

Day 15: Conclude your journey with a coach transfer from the Atlanta airport back home, filled with unforgettable memories of your Alaskan adventure.
