The Mountains of Pennsylvania & Virginia offer fantastic Fall Foliage Colors, which are best seen on a train ride into the forest. On this trip, we take three exciting train rides into the Pocono, through Penn Dutch Country and the *NEW* Alleghany Special in the Shenandoah Valley. In addition, go back in time to experience George Washington's Mount Vernon & Colonial Williamsburg, enjoy Sight & Sound's newest production JOSHUA, and many meals, including dinner with an Amish Family.

Day 1: Our trip begins as we head North through The Carolinas and into Virginia. Check into our Williamsburg, VA Hotel with a delightful welcome dinner this evening. **D**

Day 2: Share something historic at the world's largest living history museum, Colonial Williamsburg! Experience this 18th-century colonial capital of Virginia come to life as you explore the historic buildings and interact with costumed interpreters. Watch staged reenactments throughout the day and learn more about the daily lives of the diverse men and women who lived in Williamsburg before and during the American Revolution. A wonderful lunch is included at Colonial Williamsburg's historic Shields Tavern. **B L**

Day 3: Today we head to the historic home of America's first president, George Washington; Mount Vernon. A docent-led tour of the Mansion is included and a self-guided visit to the museum to discover the history and the people who shaped Mount Vernon. We now set off to Penn Dutch Country Lancaster Pennsylvania. Tonight, enjoy a very special dinner, as we are hosted by the Amish Family Samuel & Ruth Lapp at their Farmhouse for a traditional hearty meal. **B D**

Day 4: This morning, we board the oldest continuously operating railroad in America, The Strasburg Railroad, for an historic steam train ride through the world-famous Amish farmland. Travel through some of the most beautiful, peaceful, and productive Pennsylvania Dutch Countryside, with a stop in Paradise, PA. From this unique vantage point, you'll see Amish farmers working in their fields, Amish children playing nearby; livestock grazing, and

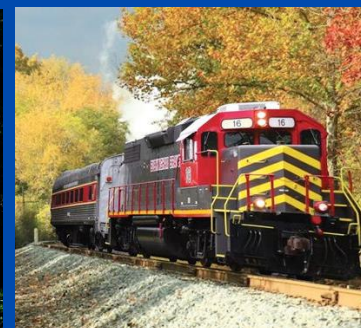
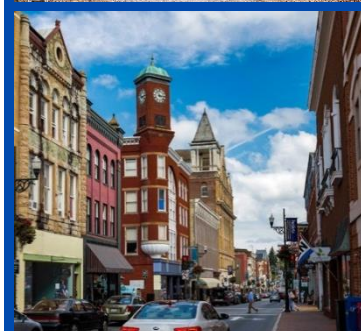
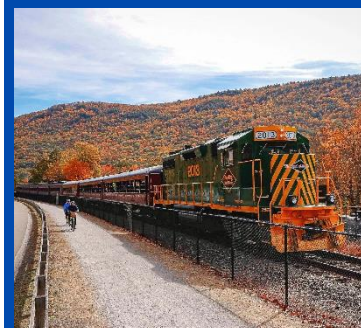
farm produce waiting to be harvested. This afternoon features the matinee show at Sight & Sound, for their newest production, JOSHUA! From the banks of the Jordan River to the towering walls of Jericho, JOSHUA is a miraculous adventure. Journey alongside the people of Israel as they navigate their new-found freedom in an unforgiving wilderness. When Joshua is called to replace Moses as their faithful leader, tensions mount in the midst of dwindling supplies and approaching armies. With one last fortified city standing between the Israelites and the Promised Land, unexpected help emerges from behind enemy lines and Joshua's trust in God's plan is put to the ultimate test. A Penn Dutch dinner is included after the show. **B D**

Day 5: Our next destination will be a sweet one as we reach the town of Hershey, PA. Here we tour the Hershey Story Museum, which takes visitors on a journey through the life of Hershey Chocolate creator Milton S. Hershey, his chocolate company, his generous philanthropic legacy, and the town of Hershey. Next, indulge in a chocolate tasting, from fruity African chocolate flavors to Indonesian chocolate with caramel overtones. Here, you shall hone your skills as a cocoa connoisseur! Overnight in the Pocono Mountains near the town of Jim Thorpe, with dinner included. **B D**

Day 6: The town of Jim Thorpe, PA is a historic town nestled in the Lehigh Gorge, Carbon County, and is one of the great gems of the Poconos Mountains. Here, we jump onto the Lehigh Gorge Scenic Railway. Follow the majestic Lehigh River over bridges, Glen Onoko, and the Lehigh Gorge State Park. High-rising cliffs, mountain scenery, and wildlife surround the train along the forested route to Old Penn Haven. Spend some time exploring this quaint mountain town before continuing the journey through the Shenandoah Valley and to the town of Staunton Virginia for the next two nights. Another dinner is included this evening. **B D**

Day 7: Today is sure to be one of the highlights of the trip as we join the new Virginia Scenic Railway and their 3-hour train ride onboard the Alleghany Special. Experience the charm and beauty of Virginia's Shenandoah Valley as we venture westward through beautiful farmland, a destination bound for the George Washington and Jefferson National Forests. Enjoy stunning views of the Alleghany Mountains before reaching the hamlet of Goshen in Rockbridge County, where we turn around and return to Staunton. Lunch and dessert are included and are served onboard. This evening, enjoy our final farewell dinner. **B L D**
