On this incredible trip we will explore New Brunswick, Prince Edward Island, Nova Scotia and then Newfoundland! Also included is Bar Harbor Maine & Acadia National Park.

## PASSPORT REQUIRED

**DAY 1:** Our adventure commences with a flight to Boston, MA where we shall meet our coach and travel up into the State of Maine. Check into the hotel with an included dinner this evening. **D**

**DAY 2:** Following breakfast and we travel up through the heart of the woodlands of Maine and cross the border into New Brunswick, Canada. Our destination is St John, a city along the shores of the Bay of Fundy. Our group will have time to grab some dinner and enjoy the waterfront at leisure. **B**

**DAY 3:** This morning, we leave the Province of New Brunswick and cross onto Prince Edward Island Province via the 7-mile Confederation Bridge, that spans the Northumberland Strait. It's a short drive to the north shore of the island where we visit Green Gables, where Lucy Maud Montgomery, an island native, wrote her famous "Anne of Green Gables" novel. Next, we make our way to the capital city of Charlottetown and check into our hotel. Tonight's dinner will be on Fisherman's Wharf, famed for its local abundant and delicious seafood. **B D**

**DAY 4:** Today we travel to the Southernmost point on P.E.I. and take the ferry over the Northumberland Strait to the town of Pictou, Nova Scotia. Continue our travels through quaint fishing villages and along cozy harbors and on to spectacular Cape Breton. Arriving in Baddeck, our first stop is at the Alexander Graham Bell Museum. Mr. Bell loved Baddeck and spent his summers here, as well as building a home on the lake. Later we check into our resort hotel in Baddeck for a two-night stay near the shores of the Bras D'Or Lakes. Enjoy dinner in the resort's restaurant! **B D**

**DAY 5:** Today is bound to be one of the most spectacular days of the entire tour, as our motorcoach follows the famed Cabot Trail in a circle of Cape Breton Island, with the mountains meeting the water and forming the ruggedly magnificent coastline! The climbing road up "Old Smoky" offers breathtaking vistas of the surrounding seacoast as we travel along one of the most scenic and beautiful highways in North America! A local guide will accompany us providing historical and regional history, folklore and other interesting facts on the sights we shall see along the way. We'll have a special lunch at the majestic Keltic Lodge, situated on a peninsula jutting into the crashing waves of the North Atlantic, and then continue the scenic loop down Ole Smoky and back to Baddeck.

**DAY 6:** Journey to The Fortress of Louisbourg, which is a National Historic Site of Canada and the location of a one-quarter partial reconstruction of an 18th-century French fortress. Its two sieges, especially that of 1758, were turning points in the Anglo-French struggle for what today is Canada. By late afternoon we will travel to Sydney NS and board the Marine Atlantic Ferry for an overnight cruise to Newfoundland. Relax in modern, spacious cabin accommodations with everything needed to ensure your journey is smooth and relaxing. Enjoy an onboard dinner, then perhaps take a stroll along the decks and enjoy breathtaking panoramic ocean views and fresh air or check out the modern amenities indoors before retiring to your comfy cabin for the night. **B D**

**DAY 7:** Breakfast is included onboard before we dock in Argentia, Newfoundland. After disembarkation we drive to North America's oldest city, St. John's where we meet our local guide for a tour of the National Historic Park. Visit Signal Hill, the iconic Cabot Tower and Cape Spear home to the oldest lighthouse and the most easterly point in North America. Along the way take in magnificent views and watch for abundant wildlife both on land, in the air and out to sea. We overnight in St. John's area with dinner included. **B D**

**DAY 8:** Following breakfast we shall drive the short distance to Bay Bulls; a small fishing village located just a short distance from St. John's. Here, we board a Puffin & Whale Watch boat and sail out of the sheltered harbor and discover the nautical wonders of the rugged coastline and its fantastic wildlife. Following our boat ride, we will enjoy an included lunch, then continue our journey northwest to the Grand Falls area, where we have accommodations for the next two nights. **B L**

**DAY 9:** A day trip out to the scenic rocky coast of Notre Dame Bay to the infamous "Iceberg Alley" and the historic town of Twillingate. Following an included lunch, we'll explore Iceberg Alley with Newfoundland's award-winning boat tour! Marvel at 12,000-year-old icebergs on their epic journey from Greenland; observe majestic humpback whales as they feed in Twillingate's coastal waters, and watch elegant seabirds frolic along the coastline. From the Arctic Circle all the way to Newfoundland and beyond, experience these 12,000-year-old Greenland icebergs up close and personal. Hear the ice crack under the Newfoundland sun and see their fissures and scars shimmer against a scenic backdrop. A truly remarkable experience to behold. **B L**

**DAY 10:** Today we depart for Gros Morne National Park, which provides one of the world's greatest geology lessons. Explore towering inland fjords and see how the continents got their shape, why continents collide and tear apart, only to collide again. View lush parks with grazing moose & caribou, tremendous waterfalls and much more in this UNESCO World Heritage destination. We'll view Lobster Cove Head Lighthouse while in Rocky Harbor and take a boat cruise on Bonne Bay. Then we'll even have a chance to partake in an age-old tradition know as a "screech in", featuring live traditional music, a Cod fish, Sou'wester, and a little of the famous Newfoundland Screech.....you'll see! Come away with a certificate declaring us an "honorary Newfoundlander". Lunch will be included today. Later this afternoon we continue to Corner Brook, where we will spend the night with an included dinner. **B L D**

**DAY 11:** It's time to say farewell to Newfoundland as we drive to Port-aux-Basque to catch our ferry back to Nova Scotia. Enjoy the 6-hour passage with an included lunch aboard the ferry. Upon arrival in Sydney, Nova Scotia check into the hotel with an evening at leisure. **B L**

**DAY 12:** Travel today to Halifax to meet a local guide for an afternoon tour of the city. Discover the harbor and the bustling waterfront. View Province House, the oldest parliament building in Canada, and the Citadel, an imposing fortress on the highest hill in the city, as well as the Royal residence of the King when in Halifax. Check into our Halifax hotel for the next two nights. **B**

**DAY 13:** This morning, we shall circle the peninsula out of Halifax to picturesque Peggy's Cove, with its most photographed lighthouse in Canada, located on a beautiful coastline! Lunch is included at the Sou'wester Restaurant with time to wander and shop around this working fishing village, before returning to the city. **B L**

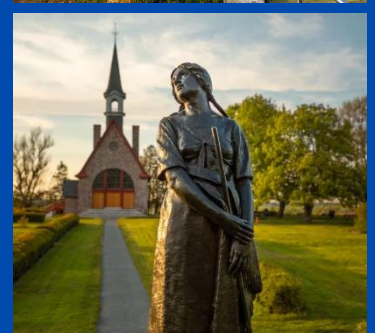


**DAY 14:** Depart Halifax and drive the famed Evangeline Trail immortalized in Longfellow's epic poem of two people separated by the turbulent times. This becomes alive as we visit Grand Pre, a memorial to the native French-speaking people who were deported to the Louisiana Territory as the British rule of the country began. Arrive in the town of Digby, known for its scallop fishing, and enjoy a special luncheon at the elegant Pines Resort. Continue on this coastal route along the Bay of Fundy for our final night in Yarmouth Nova Scotia. **B L**

**DAY 15:** This morning, we embark on the CAT, a highspeed ferry which in just 3 ½ hours will whisk us across the Gulf of Maine to the beautiful port of Bar Harbor. Enjoy a lunch included in the town before heading out to Acadia National Park on Mount Desert Island, the largest rock-based island on the Atlantic Coast. The beauty of the sea, mountains, lakes, and woodlands has painted this region into a summer paradise. We will tour this natural wonderland, seeing granite cliffs rising from the ocean, peaks bare at their summits, more varieties of wildflowers than can be counted, and Cadillac Mountain, the highest point along the Atlantic coast of the USA, rising 1530ft above sea level. Overnight in Bangor Maine. **B L**

**DAY 16:** It's time to make our way back towards the airport with one last overnight in the Boston area with a farewell dinner. **B D**

**DAY 17:** Join our flight back home to Savannah after a fantastic trip filled with many unique memories from our adventure up to the North Eastern Provinces of Canada. **B**
