**DAY 2:** After Breakfast which is included daily at the Inn, we shall head out to the National Elk Refuge Preserve. Wrap up nice & warm and bring a blanket, as we hop onto a horse drawn sleigh which takes us on an incredible adventure through the National Elk Refuge. When you climb into a horse drawn sleigh you will find yourself in the middle of a western adventure unlike any other. This century long tradition continues to be a one-of-a-kind for wildlife viewing. As you venture across the Refuge to the sounds of snow crunching beneath the horses' feet, listen to the wealth of information and amazing facts provided by your guide. Learn about how the National Elk Refuge came to be and why it is important still today, and hear fascinating facts about the elk themselves, as you sit just feet away from these majestic animals. You may also encounter other wildlife such as eagles, coyotes, foxes, badgers, bison, deer, wolves, as well as trumpeter swans, ducks, geese and a variety of other birds. Each ride is unique, and you never know what you will see next, all amidst the beauty of Wyoming's most scenic landscape. **B**

### **OPTION 2: Half Day Winter Grand Teton Sunrise Wildlife Tour**

Step onboard a specially customized Mercedes-Benz Sprinter van for a half-day interpretative tour designed for wildlife viewing. Mornings come alive in Grand Teton National Park's diverse and vibrant ecosystem, which is the natural habitat for elk, moose, bighorn sheep, birds of prey, and wolves. Explore the beauty of the southern half of the park including panoramic views of Grand Teton peak at 13,775 ft in elevation. This magnificent ecosystem comes alive in the winter, and this tour offers ample opportunity for winter wildlife viewing while learning about the ecology, natural history, and cultural history of the Greater Yellowstone Ecosystem.
